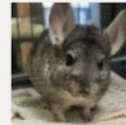
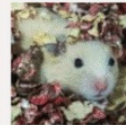


MEET SASHA

Sasha is our 80,000th Spay/Neuter Patient. In April, Dakin's Community Spay/Neuter Clinic treated its 80,000th patient, a friendly seven-month old miniature schnauzer named Sasha, who lives in Springfield. Her family was able to take advantage of a lowered surgical fee for people receiving financial assistance, which made Sasha's successful surgery happen. That's just one of the many safety-net services you make possible that keep pets with their people.

As an open admission shelter, we don't turn any animal away. We took in 3,236 cats, 1,284 dogs and a record-breaking 965 smalls (birds, rabbits, guinea pigs and other species). Together, we celebrate the joy that animals bring into our lives while welcoming and supporting the pets and people that face challenges.

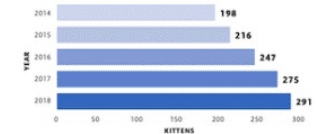
GREEN INITIATIVES

Last summer we treated the 1,000th patient at Nick's Nursery, New England's only kitten intensive care unit. Each year since it opened in 2014, you have allowed us to treat hundreds of at-risk orphaned kittens who had no other options, steering them toward the road to adoption.
